Printable daily cleaning checklist for supermarkets, food retail stores, grocery departments, entrances, washrooms and customer areas.

Best for: daily grocery cleaning routines, shift accountability and customer-facing store presentation.

Service areas: Chilliwack, Sardis, Vedder Crossing, Garrison Crossing, Promontory, Yarrow, Greendale, Rosedale, Fairfield Island, Cultus Lake, Abbotsford, Hope and the Fraser Valley.

Customer Areas

Done	Task	Notes / Initials
☐	Sweep, spot mop or clean sales floor traffic paths.	
☐	Clean entrance glass, mats, door handles and vestibule area.	
☐	Check checkout lanes, baskets, carts and customer touchpoints.	
☐	Clean visible spills, sticky spots and food residue immediately.	
☐	Empty customer-facing garbage and replace liners.	
☐	Clean customer service counters and high-touch surfaces.	
☐	Inspect produce and food department floors for moisture or residue.	
☐	Document recurring cleaning issues for manager follow-up.	

Back-of-House and Staff Areas

Done	Task	Notes / Initials
☐	Clean staff room tables, counters, sinks and floors.	
☐	Empty garbage in staff rooms and back rooms.	
☐	Sweep and clean receiving area traffic paths.	
☐	Inspect storage floors for debris, packaging and spills.	
☐	Check garbage area and bin surroundings for residue or odor.	
☐	Keep janitorial tools separated by cleaning zone.	

Washrooms

Done	Task	Notes / Initials
☐	Clean toilets, urinals, sinks, counters and mirrors.	

Done	Task	Notes / Initials
■	Restock soap, paper towels and toilet paper.	
■	Mop floors and check grout, corners and odor sources.	
■	Empty washroom garbage and replace liners.	
■	Clean partitions, handles and high-touch surfaces.
